Story

The town of Aléria (Alalia) was founded in the 5th century BC on the Eastern coast of Corsica. It is at a time when the Phoceans introduced the vine in Corsica. A holy land was born : Terra Santa !

The Terra Santa vineyards are ideally situated between the sea and the mountains, bathed in heat during the day and coolness at night. The local grape varieties are cultivated in homage to the traditional Mediterranean way of life and express the full knowledge of the land.

Farming philosophy : Sustainable (certified HVE 3 since 2021)

Grape varieties : 50% Sciaccarellu, 25% Grenache, 25% Niellucciu

Plot size : 75 ha (185 acres)

Average age of the vines : 25-30 years

FARMING PRACTICES

- Training method : Guyot double
- No herbicides
- Grass every 2 rows
- Sustainable farming

Winemaking

- Mechanical harvest by night / Destemmed
- Direct pressing rosé
- Cold settling at 50°F
- Pneumatic press
- Fermentation : Temperature-controlled stainless-steel tank / 21 days
- No malolactic fermentation
- Aging : 3 months in stainless steel tank
- Fined : Yes
- Filtration : Yes
- Vegan : Yes

Tasting notes

Fresh and bright, filled with strawberry fruit with a twinge of salty sea brine. This Rosé has a beautiful forward nose with plenty of mouthwatering acidity on the finish
